Dear Candidate,

Please refer to your application for admission to the M.Tech. Program in the Department of Chemistry, IIT Delhi. You are invited to attend the interview on 17th May, 2019 in **Room No. LH602, 5th Floor, Lecture Hall Complex (LHC), IIT Delhi**. Before coming please ensure that you meet the shortlisting criteria displayed on the department webpage: <http://chemistry.iitd.ac.in>.

Please bring the following documents with you:

1. Original Degrees/Certificates, mark sheet and GATE Score CSIR/UGC National Test result (with documents clearly supporting your claim).
2. No Objection Certificate from the employer, if applicable. The certificate should contain that he/she has enough time to devote for research; facilities for research in the candidate's field are available at the place of work, he/she will be permitted to reside at the Institute for not less than 12 months.
3. Two passport size photographs.

Please note that:

1. In view of restricted hostel accommodation, it will not be possible to provide such accommodation to those selected candidates whose parents/guardians reside in Delhi.
2. No TA is admissible to the candidates appearing for test/interview for admission to M.Tech. / M.S.(Research) / M.Des. programmes.
3. Fee once paid for a particular programme will not be adjusted/ transferred if the student gets selected subsequently and joins in another programme. He/She will have to pay the fee for the new programme he/she joins and apply for refund of fee earlier paid for a programme he/she wishes to withdraw. The refund of fee will be made as per rules of the Institute.
4. Candidates coming for test/interview for admission will be provided accommodation in **Zanskar (for boys) and Himadri (for girls) hostels** on sharing basis on payment of **Rs. 400/- per day** (lodging and boarding) as detailed below. The bedding is not provided and the candidates have to make their own arrangement for bedding. The payment shall be made by way of **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of "**Deans Discretionary Funds, IIT Delhi (hostel name) Hostel**".

5. Sponsored/Self-financing candidates will be interviewed only on production of a documentary proof of financial support and No Objection Certificate (NOC) from employer. Please cross-check the necessary requirements from the Institute website (*Post Graduate Admission-Detailed Brochure*)
6. The list of selected candidates (*Provisional*) is likely to be known by the evening of the third working day after the date(s) of interview with the subject of approval from Dean (Academic).
7. The selected candidates may collect the admission letters from the office of the Chemistry Department after approval of the Dean. The waiting list (if any) will be operated as per institute rules.
8. The selected candidates are required to pay the fees within the stipulated period as given in the admission letter. Non-compliance by the candidates will result in cancellation of admission.
9. New entrants will have to give an undertaking at the time of hostel allotment that they will not keep any motor driven vehicles on the campus.
